The Simple Past Tense

The simple past tense expresses an action that was completed in the past.

Example 9.1

an QiKun (QiKwn) I ate
enti genjruKw You slept (Singular)
gaim mihrotl feruKw Gaim went to school
ent=B9n QaldnuKw You saw (Plural)
yn AwtitnuKwn We succeeded
naw sabiniKw They praised

The verb agrees with the subject (person) and the suffixes are: Example 9.2

-Kun (Kwn)

The simple past tense of the verb enkelna, to love. The suffixes in the present tense end in kun ekw etc. (see Lesson 8) while they change to Kw in the simple past tense.
